Here is a photo of our State Governments latest weapon against anyone who thinks that they can use their own judgement and drive above the posted speed limit... Even the Queensland Police Union dismisses



covert speed cameras as "poker machines on wheels", but Premier Anna Bligh insists they are an important tool to help cut the state's road toll. Anna wouldn't lie to us would she?? I just hope the State Government doesn't use this years low fatality rates as justification as the toll was actually

down 41% from the 2009 figure when they were introduced in early April 2010 and presently is only down 29% (the road toll as at Nov 14, 2010 stands at 213) from the same time in 2009.

Well, I won't bang on to much about the poor finish to the Formula 1 season for Mark Webber fans, but I must say, if there was one person I really didn't want to win the World Championship on the weekend, it was that annoying little German Sebastien Vettel.

One good thing about watching every one of Webbers races (apart from the Australia GP in 2009 when we brought our first son home) over the past 9 years is that I knew not to get my hopes up, mainly because there has been so many disappointments and bad luck for Mark over the years. The 2010 title seemed to turn for the Australian at the Korean Grand Prix late last month when he crashed the Red Bull into the wall in the wet, all on his very own. Anyway, I suppose there's always next year.

The 2010 World Rally Championship also wrapped up on the weekend with the last round in Great Britain. It was another win for World Champion Sebastien Loeb taking his third rally in a row and eighth for the year. Wales Rally GB also marked the end of the current two-litre World Rally Car era before they are replaced by the all-new S2000 formula at the start of next season. Next years WRC season kicks off in Sweden on the 13th of February. Rally Australia will be round 10 of 13 for 2011 and will be held in Coffs Harbour, NSW in early September.

Great Alpine Sprint

Based in Mt Beauty in the heart of the Victorian alpine region, the Great Alpine Sprint (GAS) promises 240 competitive kilometres of challenging mountain roads, making up more than 50 percent of the rally's total 460km distance.

The event invites both Classic cars (pre-1982) and Modern cars (1982 onwards) to compete against the clock in full rally competition, or in a non-competitive closed-road touring section for performance vehicles without rollcages or rally compliance.

The price for three thrilling days of rally is just \$2950 for competition cars, and \$950 for touring cars. Strict road closure times have translated to a capped field of no more than 140 competitive entries and 30 touring cars, and places are expected to go quickly.
