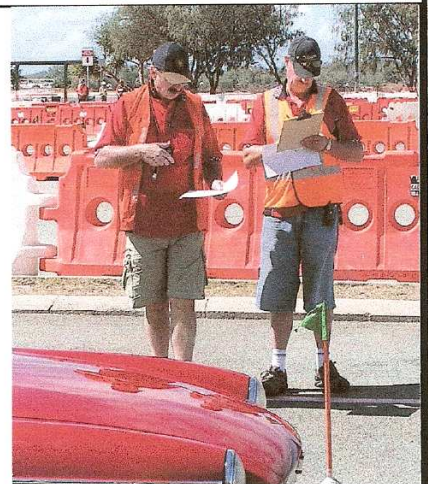

Update

To keep members informed regarding the 'Tarmac Rally' that we are conducting at Willowbank Park on the 22nd September 2007 I have noted below what has been done to date. The event is designated as a Tarmac Rally to meet the CAMS Standing Regulations regarding a rally that includes tarmac. This brings with it a major shift in the event structure to that which usually constitutes a 'normal rally'. The route will consist of approximately 3 km tarmac, 1.3 km composed granite racing circuit and the remainder smooth fine gravel. All surfaces are flat, smooth, fast and flowing. The event will run day and night, under lights. Willowbank Raceway and the IWMAC Sprint Track have been secured. A 5km route has been promulgated. Permit applications are with the Ipswich City Council and the Ipswich Police and they are 'progressing through the respective systems'. I have met with Qld Rally Panel and a submission has been presented to ARCom. The CAMS Rally Manager has been actioning the submission. Greg Carr, ARComs' Tarmac Rally Checker, has reviewed the concept ... at the venue. ALL parties have been very supportive and are desirous of the event proceeding. A Clerk of Course has been nominated. Vehicle eligibility is currently being discussed. Simply put eligible vehicles both classic and modern will be those that are capable of meeting the technical requirements for rallying. An FIV has been booked. Costings have been obtained regarding barriers and lighting. Discussion have been had regarding linking the rally's promotion with that for Speed on Tweed as they are two events close together on the calendar and have some commonalities. We are serious about this major event and need the whole club's assistance. Please contact John Careless on 5534 8986 or at rcare5@eq.edu.au if you wish to assist.
